NATIONAL AWARDS AWARD SPONSOR | £4,000 PER AWARD

Apprenticeship Equality, Diversity & Inclusion Award (NEW FOR 2023)

This award recognises apprentice employers and/or providers who've made an outstanding effort to increase the diversity of apprentices they work with. This award focusses on those organisations who can evidence a commitment to ensuring fair treatment and opportunity for all. Aiming to eradicate prejudice and discrimination on the basis of an individual or group of individual's protected characteristics..

The Widening Participation Recognition Award (NEW FOR 2023)

This award recognises the outstanding activity of a provider or employer during a previous five-year period regarding widening participation. Applicants must demonstrate how they've successfully led a campaign to fully embrace apprenticeships to recruit apprentices with personal characteristics such as gender, long-term unemployed, ethnicity, English as a second language, former offenders, special educational need, and disabilities.

Apprenticeship Champion of the Year (NEW FOR 2023)

This award recognises the outstanding contribution of an individual to the development and promotion of apprenticeships. This could be from any perspective, local to national, subject-specific to sector-wide.

Apprenticeship Provider of the year

This award will recognise excellence in the delivery of apprenticeships from a single provider. It is open to all types of apprenticeship provider, not limited to the sectors covered by the subject awards.

Apprentice Employer of the Year

This award recognises outstanding commitment to apprentices and apprenticeships within an organisation. It is open to employers from all sectors and all sizes.
